COVID 19 Protocols-Updated November 2022

The safety of our clients and staff is of paramount importance. As a result, we have implemented the following protocols. Our protocols are consistent with CDC Guidelines but are conservative, as some of the individuals we serve are at high risk for severe illness. Please be aware that changes may be made if the COVID situation in the area changes.

In Home/Group Home Services

1. Mask wearing during therapy is at the discretion of the therapist, client, and caregivers.
2. A work area which has been disinfected prior to the beginning of therapy must be available for the therapist to work in.
3. Although, social distancing may not be able to be maintained between the therapist and the individual receiving therapy, caretakers and other household members must remain 6 feet away from the therapist.
4. Please cancel your appointment if anyone in the household has a fever of 100 degrees or above, is feeling unwell, or has been exposed to someone with a positive COVID test. Likewise, your therapist will cancel if he/she has a fever, symptoms or has had an exposure.
